

Art Maui 2017 - High School Senior Scholarship Awards Program

To: Maui County High School Senior Students & Teachers

Art Maui is very pleased to continue its High School Senior Art Scholarships to culminate during Art Maui 2017. High school seniors attending high school and home school in Maui County are invited to participate. We thank you very much and look forward to having senior students take advantage of these scholarships given out to the college of the student's choice. This year Art Maui 2017 will be giving out Four Scholarships - 3 Students receiving \$2000 each. In addition one \$1000 Honorable Mention Award will be given. These scholarships will be forwarded to the admissions offices of the schools of the students' choice at the appropriate time within 2 years of student being awarded the scholarship.

Each participating High School Senior may drop off one portfolio of their artwork. The portfolio may contain artwork in Painting, Drawing, Photography, Mixed Media, Small Sculpture, and Ceramics (Boxed individually). Small 3D pieces must also be boxed up individually. Short creative videos clips are also accepted as digital media.

Scholarship Awards Presented on April 8,2017-2pm, at the Schaefer International Gallery at the MACC.

Rules and Conditions:

- 1.All entries must be originals and not copies of other artwork of any kind.
2. Artwork must have been produced during the 2016-2017 school year.
3. Each student is limited to **8** pieces of artwork in any combo of 2D/3D. Artwork must be presented in a portfolio that contains the works.
4. Entries may be in any medium.
5. Students should submit a portfolio containing a representative selection of their work which indicates a serious interest in an art profession.
6. Students should demonstrate an interest of concentration in **4** pieces the other **4** entries should demonstrate the student's breath of experience.

Originality, creativity, and quality as well as technical achievement and presentation will be considered.

7. Entrants should include a brief statement of objectives and aspirations, as well as the name of the college or school where they hope to continue their studies. Teachers may write a letter of recommendation.

8. All 2D entries must be matted or mounted with white or off white construction paper or mat board. Matted size should not exceed 36"x36"
No glass or framed art will be accepted.

9. Artwork must be submitted with an application. All submissions must be labeled and numbered and correspond to the application and attached to the back of each piece.

10. All participants enter at their own risk. Art Maui will not assume responsibility for loss or damage to artwork, though all artwork will be treated with utmost care.

11. 3D Artwork must be protected in packing material when submitted. All pieces must be packed in separate boxes to insure their safety.

12. Artwork from Molokai and Lanai can be mailed if necessary. Please email Debbie von Tempsky at debbievontempsky@gmail.com for shipping arrangements or questions.

13. All portfolios and artwork will be returned to the students on Sunday, March 26, 2017 between the hours of 9am-3pm at the Schaefer Gallery at the MACC. Please be sure to make arrangements for pick-up, for Art Maui can not be responsible for artwork that is left after that day.

14. Entrants and their family and friends are invited to attend the Artist Reception on April 1st and **Awards Ceremony will be held on April 8** at 2pm. The Ceremony will be held in the Schaefer Gallery at the MACC.

15. The Artwork of the scholarship winners will be photographed for Art Maui use for publications and will be featured in a Photo Book during the Art Maui 2017 Show. Each Scholarship winner will be presented a copy of the Photo Book at the Awards Ceremony.
