



2019-20 BOARD OF DIRECTORS RECRUITMENT PACKET

Aloha and Mahalo for your interest in joining the Art Maui Board of Directors (BOD).

Art Maui is one of the most prestigious juried art exhibitions in the County. This year, we celebrated our 41st anniversary! For the past twenty-five years the exhibition has been mounted at The Schaefer International Gallery at the Maui Arts and Cultural Center. Every year a Juror (or Jury Panel), recognized as a highly qualified artist or art expert off-island, is appointed to select the works for the upcoming Art Maui exhibition. This year we welcomed Lisa A. Yoshihara the Transit Arts Program Administrator at the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation. Of the 493 pieces submitted, in a wide variety of mediums by 305 artists, Yoshihara selected 112 works of art by 103 artists. Board members are allowed to submit their work to *Art Maui*; however, those that do are not permitted to participate on the Juror Committee.

Our current BOD consists of sixteen dedicated volunteers, five of whom serve on the Nominating Committee. Interested candidates for election to membership are screened through the Nominating Committee before they become nominees and their membership can be voted upon by the BOD. The screening process includes review of the application and an in-person interview. Nominees are invited to our Board meeting in August where they will be introduced and their induction will be brought to vote. Before the next Board meeting in September, new members will receive an orientation packet containing organization and exhibition details, a projected schedule of events, by-laws, and an organizational chart. A member's term is three years. At the end of the term, they may decide to stay on for up to three additional years. The term limit is six years, at which time, members are required to take a one-year sabbatical before considering reapplying for another term. 1. Attend all Board meetings, unless excused by the President.
2. Join a minimum of one committee.
3. Volunteer at *Receiving* and/or *Give Back* day.
4. Commit to three 3.5 hour gallery sitting shifts during the exhibition.
5. Follow all Art Maui By-Laws and MACC rules.
